

RESOLUTION RE: APPOINTMENT OF TEACHER REPRESENTATIVES TO THE LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCILS TO FILL TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE VACANCIES

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the School Reform Act, as amended November 14, 1993, the Board shall appoint teachers to fill teacher vacancies on each Local School Council after considering the preferences of the school staff as ascertained through a non-binding advisory poll of school staff; and

WHEREAS, a non-binding advisory poll was conducted at schools named herein to ascertain the preferences of the school staff regarding appointment of teachers to the local school council for that attendance center; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ch. 122 par. 34-2.1 (0) the results of the non-binding advisory polls and recommendations have been forwarded to the Board for use in its exercise of absolute discretion in the appointment process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION:

- 1. The following named individuals identified in Exhibit A are hereby appointed to serve as Local School Council members in the categories identified therein.
2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
