

AMEND BOARD RULE 6-1**THE GENERAL COUNSEL RECOMMENDS:**

The General Counsel recommends amending Board Rule 6-1 as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

The amendment adopts provisions of Public Act 92-0064 of the 92nd General Assembly, which amended the Illinois School Code, Sections 2-3.13a and 10-22.6 by adopting language that provides that a school district may adopt a policy requiring students who are suspended or expelled from other school districts to serve the full term of their suspension or expulsion before being admitted into the school district.

TEXT:

Sec. 6-1. Admission Requirements. No person shall be admitted to any school under the jurisdiction of the Board of Education without meeting the requirements for admission. No person seeking admission into any Chicago Public School who has been suspended or expelled for any reason from any public school in Illinois or any other state may be admitted without first completing the entire term of the suspension or expulsion, except on a case by case review by the Chief Education Officer or designee. Students who have been suspended or expelled from a private school may not be allowed to enroll in a Chicago Public School if they were suspended or expelled for an offense for which expulsion is a possible sanction according to the Chicago Public Schools Uniform Discipline Code.
