

**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF JEANETTE DESUZE, TEACHER AIDE,
HARLAN COMMUNITY ACADEMY**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Jeanette Desuze be approved; that notice of her dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon her within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Jeanette Desuze, a teacher aide currently assigned to the Harlan Community Academy, 9652 South Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60628, with excessive absences; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct; use of sick leave in an unauthorized manner for purposes other than allowed under Board Rules and regulations; violation of School Rules, or Board Rules, policies or procedures which result in behaviors that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work location; violation of Board Rule 4-11 regarding leaves of absence for educational support personnel; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Jeanette Desuze from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Jeanette Desuze has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Jeanette Desuze without pay.

She will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.


