**REPORT OF THE RESULTS OF THE BOARD'S REVIEW OF THE FINDINGS OF FACT AND  
RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER REGARDING THE CHARGES  
PREFERRED AGAINST CORRINE RINCK, TEACHER ASSIGNED TO  
FULTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

**TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION:**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING ACTION:**

That the results of the Board's review of findings of fact and recommendation of the Hearing Officer regarding the charges preferred against Corrine Rinck be reported. Accordingly, Corrine Rinck should be ~~dismissed~~/retained as a teacher employed by the Chicago Board of Education.

**DESCRIPTION:** Pursuant to Section 34-85 of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-85, a tenured teacher is entitled to a hearing before an impartial hearing officer appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education. After the close of the hearing, the hearing officer shall report to the Chief Executive Officer findings of fact and a recommendation as to whether or not the teacher shall be dismissed from the Chicago Board of Education's employ. The Chicago Board of Education, after receiving the hearing officer's findings of fact and recommendation, shall make a decision as to whether the teacher shall be dismissed from its employ.

On November 10, 2004, Arthur Medow, a hearing officer appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education, issued his written recommendation recommending that Corrine Rinck be reinstated by the Chicago Board of Education. Thereafter, the members of the Chicago Board of Education reviewed the transcript of the proceedings, including exhibits and post-hearing briefs, along with the recommendation of the hearing officer, and determined that it would ~~reject~~/adopt the hearing officer's findings of fact and conclusions of law, and ~~reject~~/accept his recommendation.


