APPROVE ENTERING INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH WYATT COMMUNITY AND FAMILY LIFE CENTER LOCATED AT 8950 SOUTH STONY ISLAND

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into a license agreement with Wyatt Community And Family Life Center for the use of two classrooms at 8950 South Stony Island to relieve overcrowding at McDowell School. A written license agreement for such use is currently being negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this agreement is stated below.

PREMISES: 8950 S. Stony Island consisting of two classrooms

LICENSEE: Board of Education of the City of Chicago

TERM: The term of this license agreement shall be for 2 years and 3 months commencing on April 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2003. This agreement shall have one (1) option to renew for one (1) additional year under the same terms and conditions.

USE: To relieve overcrowding at McDowell School. Hours of use will be between 7:30am to 3:30pm Monday through Friday.

LICENSE FEE: Licensee shall pay an annual fee of \$33,600, payable in monthly installments of \$2,800 for the term of the license.

OPERATION & MAINTENANCE: Licensor shall provide all utilities and maintenance at its own expense.

INSURANCE: The Board shall provide liability insurance under its self-insured coverage.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written license agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the license agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Exempt.

LSC REVIEW: LSC approval is not applicable to this action.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
