

**AUTHORIZATION TO PAY FINAL JUST COMPENSATION AWARD TO
ACQUIRE 120 S. SPAULDING STREET FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF MARSHALL-FARADAY CAMPUS PARK**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize payment of a final just compensation award of \$15,500 for 120 S. Spaulding Street for the construction of the Marshall - Faraday Campus Park. Information pertinent to this award is as follows:

OWNER: Monroe Street Church of Christ

PROPERTY: Vacant parcel of 2,665 square feet in East Garfield Park. P.I.N. 16-14-206-050

FINAL AWARD: \$15,500.

BASIS: Settlement based upon Board of Education appraisal of \$15,000, prepared by David Dubois.

PURPOSE/USE: To acquire property for the construction of the Marshall-Faraday Campus Park.

AUTHORIZATION: Such other conditions as deemed necessary by the General Counsel for the Board. Authorize the Comptroller to issue a check in the amount of \$15,500 payable to the Cook County Treasurer as final just compensation.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Exempt.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board’s Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board’s Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.




