**WARNING RESOLUTION – MARK VINCI

TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

that the Board of Education of the City of Chicago adopt a Warning Resolution for Mark Vinci and that a copy of this Board Report and Warning Resolution be served upon him.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Statute of the State of Illinois, the rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, and Board Report 80-231-19, a Warning Resolution must be adopted and issued to Mark Vinci, Teacher, to inform him that he is engaging in unsatisfactory conduct.

The conduct outlined in the Warning Resolution will result in the preferring of dismissal charges against Mark Vinci pursuant to the Statute, if said conduct is not corrected immediately, and maintained thereafter in a satisfactory fashion following receipt of the Warning Resolution.
