PROGRAM: In conjunction with the Language and Cultural program Kenwood Academy High School will send 10 students on a tour of Greece.

EDUCATIONAL VALUE/OUTCOMES: This trip is to experience first-hand the language and culture that the students have studied in the classroom.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS/TRIP INFORMATION: Arrangements for this program are being made by Greek Island Tours.

COST: The per pupil cost is \$1,300.00 which includes transportation, meals, hotel, costs, health and accident insurance, trip cancellation insurance, etc.

CHAPERONES: Supervision of students will be provided for this program pursuant to Board report 97-1217-PO1 ("Policy on Student Travel"), including proper ratio of students to adults. Touring with the students will be Renna Allissandratos (Teacher), Safiya Karimah (Teacher), and Joyce Brown (Teacher).

PARENTAL CONSENT: Written parental consent and release forms for each student are on file at Kenwood Academy High School.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the President and Secretary to execute any travel agreements necessary for this program.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Not applicable.

LSC REVIEW: Local School Council approval is not applicable to this report.

FINANCIAL: No cost to the Chicago Public Schools.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to any agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – Any agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.


Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of any agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time

to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of any agreement.

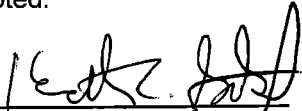

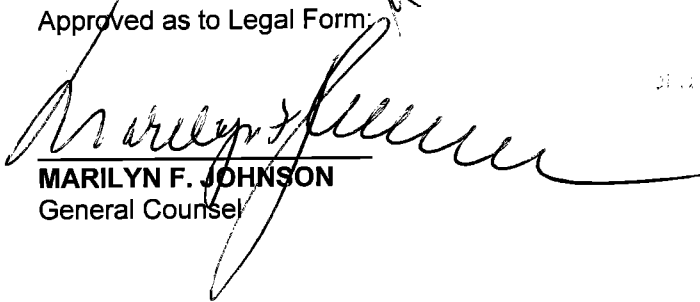
