DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM: The vendor provides services for the development and implementation of Title IV Safe and Drug Free Schools programs to the following non-public high schools: Brother Rice, De La Salle Institute, Josephinum, Mother McCauley and Queen of Peace. These services consist of training for prevention programs involving teachers, counselors, administrators, parents and students. Workshops focus on youth programs in human relations which include action based approach to foster understanding and respect in high school and create school communities characterized by inclusion, mutual respect, non-violence and participation; an interactive program designed to introduce and expose children, at an early age, to diverse cultures as well as teach them social skills required to successfully manage issues that are inherent in diverse environments. Additional materials will be supplied for the programs. As the local education agency under Title IV, the Board is required to provide educational services to non-public schools aimed at reducing drug and alcohol use and its associated violence.


COMPENSATION: Vendor shall be paid in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.




