Approve a Special On-Loan Leave of Absence for Grant Phillipp, a Teacher at Kelvyn Park High School to enable him to serve as a Visiting Master Teacher at Illinois State University in the History Department. The University shall provide the Board with a written guarantee to reimburse the Board for the salary, benefits, pension payments and related expenses that the Board pays to Mr. Phillipp during the term of the Leave. TERM: The term of this Leave and reimbursement will begin August 25, 2001 and will end June 14, 2002. By mutual consent, and subject to Board approval, this Leave may be extended for up to a twelve (12) month period under the same terms and conditions of this Leave.

SCOPE OF DUTIES: Mr. Phillipp will serve as a Master Teacher in the Department of History at ISU. He will be teaching the social science seminar at the University level. His experience with teaching in an urban environment will provide an innovative approach to ISU.


Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be followed.


