**WHEREAS**, in 1957 she worked at Harlem & Grace for Bridge School and stayed there for 34 years; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1991 until 2001 she returned to Addison & Panama and is still working that crossing; and

**WHEREAS**, she is an exemplary crossing guard, and has an excellent work record for attendance and punctuality; and

**WHEREAS**, she was born in Boone, Iowa, has 6 children, 14 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren; and

**WHEREAS**, Marcella Hageli is the most senior, active Crossing Guard serving the children of the Chicago Public Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, Marcella Hageli has faithfully performed the duties of Cross Guard for 47 years.
