

**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF MARTIN DELION, SECURITY OFFICER,
WASHINGTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Martin DeLion be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Martin DeLion, a security officer currently assigned to the George Washington School, 3611 East 114th Street, Chicago, Illinois 60617, with assault, threat, intimidation, physical or verbal abuse, by any school employee against any person on school grounds which results in physical contact; behaviors that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work locations; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 3 misconduct; behavior that grossly disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off school grounds or assigned work location; and conduct unbecoming Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Martin DeLion from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Martin DeLion has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Martin DeLion without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.


