

**RESOLUTION HONORING SHARON M. REVELLO ON HER RETIREMENT

Revello is known as a patient, gracious person who always has a smile and a kind word; as a person possessing tremendous organizational abilities and vast personal knowledge who has ensured the efficient and effective operation of the Board; as a person of great thoughtfulness and commitment who has unselfishly served the cause of education and this school district and its students; and

WHEREAS, Sharon M. Revello has been the keeper of our time at each Board meeting, the keeper of our meeting minutes and records, the keeper of vast institutional knowledge, the keeper of grace, decorum and wise counsel in every situation, and, therefore, will always be kept close in our hearts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the President and Members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, gathered here this 26th day of June, 2002, are "pleased to conclude" (although we have exceeded our two minutes of discussion of this matter), by hereby extending to Sharon M.
