**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF ROY MADLOCK, CUSTODIAL WORKER,  
MARSHALL HIGH SCHOOL**

**TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Roy Madlock be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Roy Madlock, a custodial worker currently assigned to Marshall High School, 3250 West Adams Street, Chicago, Illinois 60624, with leaving the classroom, duty assignment, or school without permission; inattention to duty including loafing, sleeping on the job, or loitering in the work area; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 1 misconduct; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct; and behavior that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work location.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Roy Madlock from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Roy Madlock has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Roy Madlock without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
