

**APPROVE PAYMENT TO PHILIPS MEDICAL SYSTEMS  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS AND ACCESSORIES**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve payment to Philips Medical Systems (Phillips) for the purchase of Automated External Defibrillators (AED) and accessories and program implementation related services for Chicago Public Schools at a cost not to exceed \$400,000.00. Vendor was selected pursuant to a bid solicitation process initiated by the State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services. A written agreement for these goods and services has been entered into by vendor and the State (Contract# 4008501), which contract grants the Board the right to purchase directly from the vendor via purchase orders.
