**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF MAURY RICHARDSON, SCHOOL BUSINESS MANAGER,
HARPER HIGH SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Maury Richardson be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Maury Richardson, a school business manager currently assigned to the Harper High School, 6520 South Wood Street, Chicago, Illinois 60636, with theft or unauthorized possession of school property, or use of such property for unauthorized purposes; having other school employees perform services or directing other school employees to perform services, with or without pay, for unauthorized purposes or accepting the benefits of such performance; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 3 misconduct; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Maury Richardson from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Maury Richardson has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Maury Richardson without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
