

ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE AREA FOR ENGLEWOOD AND ROBESON HIGH SCHOOLS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective immediately, change the attendance areas for Englewood Academy high school, located at 6201 S. Stewart Avenue, and for Paul Robeson high school, located at 6835 S. Normal Blvd. Students who are currently enrolled at Englewood and Robeson will not be affected by this change.

DESCRIPTION: Currently 9th grade students residing in the Englewood attendance area have the option of attending Robeson. This change will eliminate the 9th grade option.

Beginning at Ashland Avenue and 65th Street
 East to Racine Avenue

 South and east along the Dan Ryan and Chicago Skyway to Marquette Road

East to Cottage Grove Avenue
 South to 71st Street and South Chicago Avenue
 West on 71st Street to Dr Martin Luther King Drive
 South to 77th Street
 West to Halsted Street
 North to 73rd Street
 West to Ada Street
 North to 71st Street
 East to Throop Street
 North to 68th Street
 West to Loomis Boulevard
 North to Marquette Road
 West to Ashland Avenue
 North to the starting point.
