

APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF NEAR NORTH MINISTRY ALLIANCE AGREEMENT TO ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITY PEACE

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve the assignment of the Near North Ministry Alliance agreement for consulting services to Alliance for Community Peace effective May 1, 2003. This consulting agreement, originally awarded under Board Report No. 99-0922-PR17 on a non-competitive basis in response to violence in the Cabrini Green community, was originally for a one-year term commencing November 1, 1999 and ending October 31, 2000. The agreement was subsequently renewed three times under Board Reports 00-1025-PR25, 01-1128-PR30, and 02-1023-PR19, with the current renewal ending on October 31, 2003. A written assignment and assumption agreement to assign Near North Ministry Alliance's agreement and pricing schedule to Alliance for Community Peace is currently being prepared. No payment for assigned contractual duties shall be made to Alliance for Community Peace prior to the execution of the assignment and assumption agreement. 


