**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF MARIA BARRIOS, LUNCHROOM ATTENDANT,
COOPER SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Maria Barrios be approved; that notice of her dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon her within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Maria Barrios, a lunchroom attendant currently assigned to the Copper School, 1624 West 19th Street, Chicago, Illinois 60608, with being absent without leave; failure to apply for an approved leave of absence after ten consecutive days of absence; excessive absences; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 ;misconduct and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Maria Barrios from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Maria Barrios has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Maria Barrios without pay.

She will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
