

**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF NIURA SANCHEZ, LUNCHROOM CASHIER,
SULLIVAN HIGH SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Niura Sanchez be approved; that notice of her dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon her within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Niura Sanchez, a lunchroom cashier currently assigned to the Sullivan High School, 8331 South Mackinaw, Chicago, Illinois 60617, with being absent without leave; failure to apply for an approved leave of absence after ten consecutive days of absence; excessive absences; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 3 misconduct; violation of School Rules, or Board Rules, policies or procedures which result in behaviors that grossly disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work location; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Niura Sanchez from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Niura Sanchez has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Niura Sanchez without pay.

She will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.




