**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF DONALD GILLIAM, SPEECH LANGUAGE PATH
PARAPROFESSIONAL, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATION DISORDERS**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Donald Gilliam be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Donald Gilliam, a speech language path paraprofessional currently assigned to the Department of Communication Disorders, 125 South Clark Street, 8th Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60603, with insubordinate actions, including failure to carry out a rule, order or directive related to the performance of the employee's duty; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 1 misconduct; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Donald Gilliam from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Donald Gilliam has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Donald Gilliam without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.


