

**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF LEMUEL HOGUE, INVESTIGATOR IV,
LAW DEPARTMENT**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Lemuel Hogue be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Lemuel Hogue, an Investigator IV currently assigned to the Law Department (formerly assigned to the Office of Instruction and School Management), 125 South Clark Street, 7th Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60603, with incompetence or inefficiency in the performance of the duties of the position; making false, inaccurate or deliberately incomplete statements in an official inquiry, investigation or other official proceeding; violation of confidentiality of personnel records of school employees; failing to perform any duty required by the Chicago Public Schools' Code of Ethics, Board Report NO. 99-0728-P01, Section 3 regarding fiduciary duty to the Board and Section 13 regarding disclosing confidential information; flagrant acts of Group 3 misconduct; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Lemuel Hogue from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Lemuel Hogue has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Lemuel Hogue without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.


There will be a vacancy in the position of Investigator IV in the Law Department.
