

**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF ALBERT WISE, CUSTODIAL WORKER,
HOLDEN SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Albert Wise be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Albert Wise, a custodial worker currently assigned to the Holden School, 1104 West 31st Street, Chicago, Illinois 60608, with reporting to work under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs; violation of School rules or Board rules, policies or procedures which result in behaviors that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work locations; the manufacture, distribution, possession, consumption or use of drugs or alcohol on Board of Education property or premises or any site of Board sponsored activities; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Albert Wise from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Albert Wise has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Albert Wise without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
