

APPROVE SABBATICAL LEAVE FOR MARK HANAFEE

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve sabbatical leave of absence, with Board approval, for member of the teaching force for a period not to exceed ten school months and not less than five school months for resident study, travel, or other purposes designed to improve the service of the teacher to the Chicago Public Schools.

DESCRIPTION:

Teachers on sabbatical leaves agree to return to service in the Chicago Public Schools for a period of at least two years thereafter, and shall be returned to the position formerly occupied. When a sabbatical leave is granted, the absence shall not be construed as a break in service.

The following teacher has applied and been approved for a sabbatical leave to travel as noted from September 1, 2004 – June 30, 2005
