CHANGE GRADE STRUCTURE AT BATEMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND ADJUST ATTENDANCE BOUNDARY OF MARSHALL MIDDLE SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Change grade structure at Newton Bateman Elementary School (Unit 2190), located at 4220 North Richmond Street, and adjust the attendance boundary of Thurgood Marshall Middle School (Unit 7520), located at 3900 North Lawndale Avenue.

DESCRIPTION:

Currently seventh and eighth graders in the Bateman attendance area attend Marshall Middle School.

Effective July 1, 2004, change the grade structure at Bateman from pre-kindergarten through sixth grade, to grades pre-kindergarten through grade seven.

Effective July 1, 2005, change the grade structure at Bateman from prekindergarten through seventh grade, to grades pre-kindergarten through grade eight.

A Public Hearing was held on May 20, 2004, at the Board Offices located at 125 S. Clark Street, accepting the proposed grade and boundary changes.

Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Thurgood Marshall Middle School (Unit 7520)

Grades seventh through eighth:

Northwest to Addison Street

Beginning at Pulaski Road and Irving Park Road East to Springfield Avenue North to Belle Plaine Avenue East to Ridgeway Avenue North to Berteau Avenue East to Lawndale Avenue North to Cullom Avenue East to Monticello Avenue North to Montrose Avenue East to Drake Avenue North to Sunnyside Avenue East to Spaulding Avenue North to Wilson Avenue East to Kedzie Avenue South to Montrose Avenue West to Sawyer Avenue South to Cullom Avenue West to Spaulding Avenue South to Irving Park Road West to Kimball Avenue South to Elston Avenue Southeast to Addison Street West to Kimball Road South to the C&NW railroad

North to Leland Avenue
East to Sacramento Avenue
East to Montrose Avenue
East to the north branch of the Chicago River
South to Irving Park Road
West to Spaulding Avenue
North to starting point.

Adjust the grade structure at Newton Bateman Elementary School (Unit 2190)

Effective July 1, 2004, Bateman will serve grades pre-kindergarten through seventh grade.

Effective July 1, 2005, Bateman will serve grades pre-kindergarten through eighth grade.

East to the North branch of the Chicago River

West to Spaulding Avenue
