PROVIDE RESTRUCTURED SCHOOL DAYS AT SELECTED ATTENDANCE CENTERS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Amend the 2004-2005 regular and year-round school calendars to provide a restructured day calendar for the attached 61 schools. These restructured day calendars are different from those approved in Board Reports 04-0526-ED8 and 04-0526-ED9. The school day is restructured so that the school may provide inservice training programs and other staff development activities for teachers without falling below the minimum hours of instruction required by the Board of Education and the Illinois School Code.

DESCRIPTION: These 61 schools wish to restructure the length of their instructional school day to allow them to schedule various inservice and other staff development activities for their teachers. In order to do this while still providing the requisite numbers of instruction hours, the school has proposed that additional minutes be added to each school day. Once the extra minutes have accumulated, a shortened school day will be scheduled with the remaining time will be reserved for staff development activities.

Board Rule 6-22 provides that the specific hours of operation of each attendance center may vary to reflect the scheduling needs of each school. All schools are required to maintain regular hours of operation that provide all students with a minimum of 300 minutes of instructional work per day. These schools have submitted restructured calendars have been thoroughly reviewed to ensure that students receive the minutes of instruction as required by Board Rule 6-22 and the Illinois School Code.
