

**AUTHORIZE PAYMENTS TO VARIOUS TREATMENT FACILITIES  
FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS  
INSTRUCTED IN PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALS**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Authorize payment to the various hospitals and psychiatric treatment facilities identified below which provide short-term educational services to Chicago Public School students instructed in these facilities during the FY2005. All facilities identified below have provided such services to the Chicago Public Schools in the past and one or more may provide services in the current fiscal year. The cost of these services is approximate because services must be provided on an "as needed" basis. Total cost for FY2005 should not exceed \$105,851.00. No written agreements are required for this program, as students are placed in a treatment facility pursuant to a recommendation from the student's legal guardian or physician, or pursuant to a court order. **PAYMENT PERIOD:** Payment to the Hospitals is authorized for the period commencing September 1, 2004 and ending August 31, 2005.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:** Students may be admitted to the treatment facilities pursuant to a recommendation of the student's legal guardian, physician or pursuant to a court order. The Board is required to provide educational services to these students during their hospital stays pursuant to Illinois Administrative Code (Chapter 1, Section 226.335) which states "The Home and Hospital Services program shall be provided to any child with a health or physical impairment which, in the opinion of a licensed medical examiner, will cause an absence from school for two more consecutive weeks, and for whom school personnel determine that such a program can be of educational benefit." These treatment facilities will provide educational services.

**DELIVERABLES:** Each treatment facility shall provide academic instruction by Illinois State certified teachers.

**OUTCOMES:** Students receiving instruction at the treatment facilities will be able to transition back into the classroom at their local schools with minimum difficulties.

**COMPENSATION:** Educational services will be provided by appropriate educational staff in each of the listed treatment facilities at the daily rate per child stated below:

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.


Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from




