RATIFY AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR SERVICES TO PREGNANT AND PARENTING TEENS

The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each Agency in the event a written document for such Agency is not executed within 120 days of the date of this Board Report. TERM: The term of each agreement will commence on July 1, 2004 and shall end June 30, 2005.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: The agencies will provide a teen parenting program for a 12 month period for Agencies will conduct intake assessment to determine the level of pregnant and parenting teens. services required. Teens will receive individual counseling, group meetings, case management, and referrals, when necessary, linked to outside agencies on an individual basis and home visit outreach.

DELIVERABLES: Agencies will submit monthly reports regarding attendance, enrollment and parental involvement to the Manager of Community Based Programs. Fiscal reports will be submitted after six months and again at the end of the program year.

OUTCOMES: Agency's services will result in a greater percentage of pregnant and parenting teens completing high school, increased number of teens connected to community resources, reduction of child abuse and neglect, lower percentage of teen subsequent births during high school and improvement of individual counseling measured by standardized scales (CGAS, GAF).

COMPENSATION: The agencies shall be paid in two installments. The first installment shall be paid upon signing of the contract and the second installment will be due after the first six months of the contract and upon review of expenditure reports, in the amounts stated above, with the aggregate, not to exceed \$1,500,000.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreements. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreements.

LSC REVIEW: The Local School Council approval is not applicable to this report.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: The participation goal provisions of the Plan do not apply to transactions where the vendor is a not- for profit organization opportunity for direct or indirect participation of M/WBE's.
