

## ADOPT THE 2005-2006 YEAR ROUND CALENDARS

### THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Adopt the year-round calendars for the period of July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006.

**DESCRIPTION:** The calendars indicate holidays, teacher institute days, professional development days, and days when schools are closed for extended periods of time. These calendars also indicate student early dismissal/staff development days for School Improvement Planning.

The 2005-2006 calendars for Tracks A, B, C, and D include 174 pupil attendance days, 2 parent-teacher conference days, and 4 teacher institute days.

Madero Elementary School will operate on Track B; four schools will operate on Tracks A-D – Cuffe, Lee, Pasteur, and Sandoval.




