

AMEND THE 2005-2006 YEAR ROUND CALENDARS**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Amend the 2005-2006 Year Round Calendars in order to include the Track E year-round calendar for the period of July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. This amendment is also necessary to correct the Local School Council Elections date on Tracks A-D.

DESCRIPTION: The calendars indicate holidays, teacher institute days, professional development days, and days when schools are closed for extended periods of time. The calendars also indicate student early dismissal/staff development days for School Improvement Planning.

The 2005-2006 calendars for Tracks A, B, C, D and E include 174 pupil attendance days, 2 parent-teacher conference days, and 4 teacher institute days.

Madero Elementary School will operate on Track B; four schools will operate on Tracks A-D – Cuffe, Lee, Pasteur, and Sandoval; ten schools will operate on Track E - Casals, Chavez, Dugan Alternative High School, Drummond, Joplin, Lowell, Mays Academy, Nightingale, Powell, and Second Chance Alternative High School.


