

**APPROVE THE REVISED SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS AND BUDGET WORKSHEETS FOR  
SCHOOLS ON PROBATION**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

That the Chicago Board of Education approve the revised 2004-06 School Improvement Plans for Advancing Academic Achievement (SIPAAAs) and 2005-06 budget worksheets for the 212 Schools on Probation.

**DESCRIPTION:** The Chief Executive Officer of the Chicago Public Schools is requesting approval of the revised school improvement plans (SIPAAAs) and budget worksheets for correcting deficiencies for Schools on Probation that have completed the development of their school improvement plans pursuant to Section 5/34-8.3 of the Illinois School Code. The plans include specific steps that the local school councils and school staff must take to correct deficiencies. See the list of schools attached as exhibit A.

These revised school improvement plans and budget worksheets were submitted to the Area Offices and reviewed by the Area Instructional Officers and the individual principals prior to being submitted to the Chief Executive Officer. Individual plans were developed collaboratively at each school with the assistance of the Office of Research, Evaluation and Accountability, the Office and Management and Budget, Local School Councils and school personnel.

Once submitted to the area offices, the revised SIPAAAs and budget worksheets were reviewed to ensure that all needed areas were addressed and that the stated goals and activities were consistent with CPS instructional initiatives. All of the 2004-06 SIPAAAs contain goals to implement the Chicago Reading Initiative and the Chicago Math and Science Initiative. A plan to enhance student attendance if the attendance rate is below 95% is appended to the SIPAAA. Many plans included the following actions: implementing new reading and mathematics programs, providing professional development, expanding all day kindergarten or early childhood programs, implementing reduced class size, purchasing instructional materials, and teaching reading at the high school level. Monitoring of these SIPAAAs will be the responsibility of the area offices with the assistance of the Office of Research, Evaluation and Accountability and the Office of Management and Budget. All individuals noted in the plan will also be responsible for successful implementation of the plans.

Copies of the School Improvement Plans are available in the area offices.


