

**AMEND BOARD REPORT 06-0222-PR3**  
**APPROVE EXERCISING THE OPTION TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT**  
**WITH NATIONAL LIFT TRUCK, INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF PORTABLE LIFTS**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve exercising the option to extend the agreement with National Lift Truck, Inc for the purchase of portable lifts to the Department of Operations at a cost for the option period not to exceed \$ 174,233.00. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Vendor during the option period prior to the execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written document is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this option is stated below.

This amendment is necessary to correct the unit price of goods being purchased under the contract extension. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event the option document is not executed within 90 days of this amended Board Report.

**ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:** The original Agreement (authorized by Board Report 04-0324-PR4) is for a term commencing April 1 2004 and ending March 31, 2006, with the Board having two (2) options to extend for twelve (12) month periods. The original agreement was awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to a duly advertised Bid Solicitation (Specification No. 03-250277).

**OPTION PERIOD:** The term of this agreement is being extended for twelve (12) months commencing April 1, 2006 and ending March 31, 2007.

**OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:** There is one (1) option period for twelve (12) months period remaining.






