

**RESOLUTION RE: NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFICATION  
FOR ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS**

**WHEREAS**, the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards, organized in 1987, is comprised of teachers, school policy makers, union leaders, teacher educators and other scholars and legislators whose goal is to establish high and rigorous standards for accomplished teachers; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards has developed and currently operates a national voluntary system to assess and certify teachers who meet these standards, and to recognize and reward teachers who demonstrate high levels of competency; and

**WHEREAS**, teachers who voluntarily submit to and successfully complete the rigorous evaluation process earn a National Board Certification certificate, a nationally recognized badge, symbolizing that the teacher has exceeded standard expectations; and

**WHEREAS**, this year, a total of one hundred seventy-two Chicago Public School teachers will be awarded this National Board Certification certificate, exemplifying the goals and standards that the Board of Education encourages all teachers to emulate; and
