

**RATIFY THE PARTICIPATION OF MARSHALL METROPOLITAN HIGH SCHOOL IN AN  
EDUCATIONAL HISTORICAL BLACK COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY TOUR**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Ratify the participation of forty (40) Marshall Metropolitan High School students in an educational Historical Black College and University Tour to Kentucky State University, Frankfort, Kentucky; Alabama A & M, Huntsville, Alabama; Tougaloo College, Tougaloo, Mississippi; Jackson State University, Jackson, Mississippi; Mississippi Valley State University, Itta Bena, Mississippi; Rust College, Holly Springs, Mississippi; University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, Pine Bluff, Arkansas; and Philander Smith, Little Rock, Arkansas; from April 1, 2007 to April 7, 2007.

**PROGRAM:** A college tour to expose students to Post Secondary options complete with admissions, financial aid, and student support presentations along with campus tours.

**EDUCATIONAL VALUE/OUTCOMES:** To increase college enrollment.

**TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS/TRIP INFORMATION:** Arrangements for this program are being made by Coach USA.

**COST:** The per pupil cost is approximately \$477.00 which includes ground transportation, meals and lodging. The cost will be paid with funds from Marshall Metropolitan High School, Postsecondary Education, donations and a student fee of \$75 per student.

**CHAPERONES:** Supervision of students will be provided for this program pursuant to Board Report 03-0527-PO01 ("Policy on Student Travel"), including proper ratio of students to adults. Traveling with students will be Chicago Public Schools chaperones: Lemuel D. Rowans (PSE Coach), Etta Liddel-Walker (English Teacher), Motoya Marsh (English Teacher) and Marcus Johnson (History Teacher).

**PARENTAL CONSENT:** Written parental consent and release forms for each student are on file at Marshall Metropolitan High School.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Authorize the President and Secretary to execute any travel agreements necessary for this program.

**AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** Not applicable.

**LSC REVIEW:** The action was approved by the LSC for Marshall Metropolitan High School on March 6, 2007.




