

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AGREEMENTS WITH IT'S ABOUT TIME, A DIVISION OF HERFF JONES, INC.; KENDALL HUNT PUBLISHING CO.; PASCO SCIENTIFIC, INC.; SCIENCE KIT, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF HIGH SCHOOL TRANSFORMATION SCIENCE EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS KITS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into agreements with It's About Time, a division of Herff Jones, Inc.; Kendall/ Hunt Publishing Co.; Pasco Scientific, Inc.; Science Kit, LLC (collectively the "Vendors") for the purchase of science equipment and materials kits for schools enrolled in the High School Transformation Support for Instructional Services Program at a cost not to exceed \$3,000,000.00 during the fiscal year. The Vendors were selected on a competitive basis pursuant to a duly advertised Bid Solicitation (Specification # 07-250013). Written agreements for the Vendors' services are available for signature. No goods may be ordered or received and no payment shall be made to any Vendor prior to the execution of their written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each Vendor in the event the written agreement for such Vendor is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. TERM: The term of the agreements shall commence on July 1, 2007 and shall end on June 30, 2008.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: The Board shall have the right to terminate the agreements with 30 days written notice.

DESCRIPTION OF PURCHASE:

Goods: The materials to be purchased through the agreements with It's About Time, a division of Herff Jones, Inc.; Kendall /Hunt Publishing Co.; Pasco Scientific, Inc.; Science Kit,LLC reinforce the Support for Instructional Services component of the Chicago Public Schools (CPS) High School Transformation Project. The items to be purchased include science equipment such as microscopes and hot plates; consumable materials such as chemicals and live specimens; and durable goods such as laboratory glassware and tools.

Quantity: Materials to supply all ninth (9th) and tenth (10th) grade sections at the 25 schools participating in the High School Transformation Support for Instructional Services Program Year 2. Each laboratory in a participating school will receive a supply of equipment and durable materials for 7 student groups / 30 students. Each class section of students will be provided with a quantity of consumable materials for 7 student groups/30 students.

Additional schools will be added in Year 3 of the project; approximately 25 schools will be enrolled in Year 3, resulting in a total of 50 participating high schools.

Unit Price:

Biology Course One – \$399,166.08 for materials + cost of packaging (Kendall/ Hunt Publishing Co.)

Biology Course Two – \$665,922.79 for materials - (Packaging and shipping cost are included in materials quote) (Science Kit, LLC)

Environmental Science Course – \$194,778.28 for materials + cost of shipping (Packaging cost is included in materials quote)(It's About Time, a division of Herff Jones, Inc.)

Chemistry Course One – \$371,585.70 for materials – (Packaging and shipping cost are included in materials quote) (Science Kit,LLC)

Chemistry Course Two – \$617,567.24 for materials - (Packaging and shipping cost are included in materials quote) (Science Kit,LLC)

Chemistry and Physics Course – \$137,990.76 for materials + cost of shipping (Packaging cost is included in materials quote) (It's About Time, a division of Herff Jones, Inc.)

Probes/Sensors 9th Grade Biology – \$198,524.50 for probes and sensors – packaging costs are not applicable (PASCO, Scientific Inc.)

Probes/Sensors 10th Grade Chemistry Course One – \$121,693.00 for probes and sensors – packaging costs are not applicable (PASCO, Scientific Inc.)

Probes/Sensors 10th Grade Chemistry Course Two – \$135,553.60 for probes and sensors – packaging costs are not applicable (PASCO, Scientific Inc.)

Probes/Sensors 10th Grade Chemistry and Physics – \$23,039.10 for probes and sensors – packaging costs are not applicable (PASCO, Scientific Inc.)

OUTCOMES: The science materials included in the agreements will help to ensure that schools participating in the Support for Instructional Services component of the CPS High School Transformation Project are fully equipped to execute the instructional strategy developed by the educational consultants hired through implementation of Board Report 06-0125-PR17 as amended. The science materials will be packaged into kits by the Vendors according to the chapters or units of the textbooks they support in order to facilitate usage, storage, and organization for the teachers enrolled in the Instructional Support Program.

COMPENSATION: Vendor shall be paid in sum of \$3,000,000 for the contract accordance with the unit prices contained in the agreements; total for all vendors not to exceed the term.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreements. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreements. Authorize Chief

Officer of High School Programs to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate the agreements.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Pursuant to section 6.2 of the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise Contract Participation (M/WBE Plan), the Per Contract and Category Goals method for M/WBE participation will be utilized. Thus, contracts for subsequent vendors from the pool created by this contract will be subject to compliance reviews on a contract-by-contract basis. Aggregated compliance of the vendors in the pool will be reported on a monthly basis.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreements shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.


Conflicts – The agreements shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board’s Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreements.


Ethics – The Board’s Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreements.

Contingent Liability – The agreements shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budgets(s).


