APPROVE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENROLLMENT CAP AT SOUTHSIDE OCCUPATIONAL ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

The establishment of an enrollment cap at Southside Occupational Academy High School located at 7342 S. Hoyne Avenue effective July 1, 2008.

DESCRIPTION:

These changes are necessary due to the increase in enrollment over time at Southside Occupational Academy High School, a school which provides specialized programmatic services within a facility containing non-standard spaces. Given these factors, the Office of High School Programs and the Department of School Demographics and Planning recommend that the enrollment of students with disabilities should not exceed 150. Currently Southside Occupational serves students with disabilities starting at their third year of high school. They have a current enrollment of 218 students. No additional students will be placed by the Office of Specialized Services (OSS), the Area Office or the School Principal until the enrollment is below 150 students. When the student enrollment falls below 150 students, placement will occur pursuant to a student's IEP and subject to approval by the OSS.
