- **WHEREAS**, as Senior Manager, she oversaw the recruitment, development and evaluation of 75 new schools that provide high quality educational choice to parents and students in priority neighborhoods throughout Chicago; and
- **WHEREAS**, Jeanne L. Nowaczewski developed and managed the Renaissance 2010 Request for Proposal and Transition Advisory Council process, launching a new area of community involvement and new school creation in Chicago; and
- **WHEREAS**, Jeanne L. Nowaczewski was a Founder and Board Member of the Young Women's Leadership Charter School of Chicago, the first single sex school to be chartered in Chicago; and
- **WHEREAS**, Jeanne L. Nowaczewski is recognized as a leader, advocate, colleague, mentor and friend: and
- **WHEREAS**, Jeanne L. Nowaczewski's devotion, commitment and firm determination to create school choice and improve the quality of education for countless Chicago Public Schools 'students has been invaluable.
- **NOW**, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that we, the President and Members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, gathered here this 24th day of September, 2008, do hereby extend to Ms. Jeanne L.
