

CLOSE FOUNDATIONS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:**

That effective June 30, 2009, the Chicago Board of Education close Foundations Elementary School (unit 3310, school ID 609915) ("Foundations"), located at 2040 West Adams Street, and that the students currently attending Foundations elementary return to their attendance area schools.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to the Board of Education's Policy on the Closing of Schools, 07-0523-PO2 ("the Policy"), and following a public hearing and community meeting, the Chief Executive Officer of the Chicago Public Schools ("CEO") may recommend to the Board the closing of schools for any of the reasons for such action stated in the Policy.

Pursuant to the Policy, a public hearing was convened on January 30, 2009, and a community meeting was convened on February 7, 2009, following the issuance of proper notice to receive public comment on the CEO's proposal to close Foundations due to reasons associated with space utilization. An independent hearing officer received comments and supporting documents at the hearing and meeting and kept the record open after the meeting to receive additional written comments or documentation. Transcripts of the public hearing and community meeting have been provided to the Board. The hearing officer has prepared and submitted a report regarding the CEO's proposal in which the hearing officer recommends the closing of Foundations. After receiving the hearing officer's report, the CEO has determined to recommend that the Board close Foundations effective June 30, 2009.

FINANCIAL: No additional cost to the Chicago Public Schools

LSC IMPLICATIONS: Pursuant to the School Closing Policy, Foundations' appointed Local School Council will be dissolved effective June 30, 2009 upon the closing of Foundations.

PERSONNEL IMPLICATIONS: All faculty and staff members currently assigned to Foundations will be displaced at the end of the 2008-09 school year in accordance with Board policies and any applicable collective bargaining agreements.
