ORIGINAL AGREEMENT: The original Agreement (authorized by Board Report #08-1022-PR11) in the amount of \$150,000.00 is for a term commencing October 28, 2008 and ending October 27, 2009, with the Board having two options to renew for a period of one year each. The original agreement was awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 5-4.1.

OPTION PERIOD: The term of this agreement is being extended for one year commencing October 28, 2009 and ending October 27, 2010.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option period for one year remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Consultant will continue to provide Unisys-based application-programming support to the Board. The Consultant will continue to provide maintenance enhancement and modifications to the following Legacy systems including, but not limited to, interfaces from/to MAPPER for use with student transportation, student absentee and mass out calling, and space utilization. The Consultant will also continue to provide knowledge transfer to the Student Information Residuals (SIR) team.

DELIVERABLES: Consultant will continue to provide the following deliverables:

- The programming of new/enhancements/modifications to the computerized systems, student transportation, and interfaces to and from MAPPER;
- · Technical support at Central Office; and
- The implementation of software and technical support for various departments.

OUTCOMES: Consultant's services will result in the following:

- The running of statistics for various departments;
- The maintenance and enhancement the migrated legacy applications on the new SIR server;
- The Facilitation the enabling of the new clustered production SIR servers; and
- The creation of programs with special functions requested by Central Office.

COMPENSATION: Consultant shall be paid at an hourly rate of \$75, for a total not to exceed \$140,000.00.

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES: None.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written option document. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the option document. Authorize the Chief Information Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this option agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: The M/WBE goals for this contract include 35% MBE and 5% WBE. However, the Waiver Review Committee recommends that a full waiver of the M/WBE participation goals for this contract as required by the Revised Remedial Plan be granted.

To demonstrate a good faith effort, Know-How has agreed to work with and mentor a CPS student through the Educations-To-Careers Internship Program.

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of or the letting of contracts to, former Board members

during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
