**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

That the Chicago Board of Education adopts the Warning Resolution for Stephen Tow and that a copy of this Board Report and Warning Resolution be served upon Stephen Tow.
