ADOPT FINDING THAT PUPIL IS A NON-RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO INDEBTED TO THE CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR NON-RESIDENT TUITION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Chicago Board of Education: (i) find that the custodial parents of CPS pupil (I.D.# 50369096) were non-residents of the City of Chicago from the time the parents enrolled the pupil to the 2017-2018 academic school year, for the time that the identified student attended CPS schools; (ii) hold the pupil's custodial parents accountable as indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupil's attendance in the Chicago Public Schools for the pupil's respective times of enrollment, which occurred between the 2013-2014 school year to the 2017-2018 school year, in the total amount of \$59,421.98; (iii) reject any objections by the parent to the Board's findings; and (iv) disenroll the pupil from the pupil's current school of attendance.

DESCRIPTION:

Sections 10-20.12a and 10-20.12b (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12a and 10-20.12b) of the Illinois School Code and Board Rule 5-12 authorize and empower the Board to charge tuition, not exceeding 110% of the per capita cost of maintaining its schools during the preceding school year, to pupils enrolled in the Chicago Public Schools determined to be non-residents of the City of Chicago. Further, section 10-20.12b provides that a hearing be held, when requested by the person who enrolled the pupils, to determine whether or not a pupil who is believed to be a non-resident resides within the City of Chicago. If after notice of the initial determination of non-residency, the person who enrolled the pupil does not request a hearing or, if requested, the hearing results in a finding that the pupil does not reside in the district, the person who enrolled the pupil shall be charged tuition for the period of non-resident school attendance and the pupil shall be barred from attending school in the district. A hearing was held on July 31, 2018, before an independent Hearing Officer. The Board's findings are being adopted in accordance with the Hearing Officer's recommendation.
