RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL ONE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO as follows:

- **Section 1.** Findings. The Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board") does hereby find and declare as follows:
- (a) Pursuant to the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-215 (the "Act"), the Board is required to adopt a final one-year capital improvement plan no more than 45 days after adopting the annual budget.
- (b) On August 26, 2020, the Board adopted a Resolution, which, among other things, adopted the Annual School Budget for Fiscal Year 2021 (the "FY2021 Budget").
- **Section 2.** *Initial Capital Improvement Plan.* In accordance with the provisions of the Act, on or before May 1, 2020, the Chief Executive Officer of the Board published or caused to be published a proposed one-year capital improvement plan (the "Initial Capital Improvement Plan") consistent with the provisions of the Act.
- **Section 3.** Final Capital Improvement Plan. Attached hereto as Exhibit A, which is incorporated and made a part of this Resolution, is a Final Capital Improvement Plan (the "Capital Improvement Plan") which includes the necessary information required with respect to all capital projects for which funds have been appropriated in the FY2021 Budget. The Capital Improvement Plan has been presented to the Board for consideration.
- **Section 4.** Approval of Capital Improvement Plan. The Capital Improvement Plan is hereby approved and adopted.
- Section 5. Effectiveness. This Resolution is effective and in full force immediately upon its adoption.
