AUTHORIZE THE FIRST RENEWAL AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS VENDORS TO PROVIDE SAFE HAVEN SITES AND SERVICES

THE INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the first renewal agreements with various vendors to provide safe haven sites and services to the department of Family and Community Engagement at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Financial Section of this report. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated.

No payment shall be made to any of the various vendors during the option period prior to execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written document is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report.

ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:

The original Agreement (authorized by Board Report #22-0727-PR14) in the amount of \$3,800,000 is for a term commencing September 1, 2022 and ending August 31, 2025, with the Board having two (2) options to renew for one (1) year terms. The original Agreement was awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7-3.

OPTION PERIOD:

The term of this agreement is being renewed for one (1) year commencing September 1, 2025 and ending August 31, 2026.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:

There is one (1) option period for one (1) year remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendors shall continue to provide safe haven sites and services to elementary and/or high school students in at least 33 different locations during designated time periods throughout the school year in the targeted communities. Vendors shall include workshops on study skills, conflict resolution, anger management, character building, and positive communication and provide safe places for the students to go after school, during summer, and spring breaks, and whenever there are any emergency services that are needed during the year.

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OUTCOMES:

Vendors' services shall result in the following outcomes: (1) Students' likelihood to participate in violent behavior or become a victim of violence is reduced; (2) Parents are provided child care support during daytime hours while students receive educational enrichment activities including: problem solving, positive communication strategies, anger management strategies, and discussions about violence in the community, guidance regarding truancy prevention, and tutoring in a safe environment during non-school hours

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written option document. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the option document. Authorize the Chief of Family and Community Engagement (FACE) to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this option agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:

Pursuant to the Remedial Policy for Minority-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) participation in Goods and Services contracts, the contract is an excluded transaction pursuant to the Goods and Services Policy, for the aspirational goals of 30% MBE and 7% WBE, as the agreement is a Not-for-Profit organization.
