SY12-13 ISAT Overview


- Includes changes in cut scores and more rigorous questions*
- 65% of Elementary schools saw an increase in M/E scores
- SY12-13 represents 12 years of progress
- All grades and all subjects saw an increase in both M/E and Exceeds
- FSD Pioneers have closed the gap with District average M/E in just two years; quadrupled, then tripled District growth over both years
- Welcoming Schools outpace Sending Schools scores across all subjects
- All students by race, gender and ELL scores increased; achievement gap increased slightly by race and ELL




District Reading M/E and Exceeds Scores Increase in SY13-14

ISAT Reading Scores, by Year




District Math M/E and Exceeds Scores Increase in SY13-14

ISAT Math Scores, by Year




District Science M/E and Exceeds Scores Increase in SY13-14





ISAT Scores, Meets or Exceeds, by Sending School




ISAT Scores, Meets or Exceeds, by Welcoming School

ISAT Composite, Meets or Exceeds One-Year Gains



13 of the 16 AUSL Turnarounds have outpaced the District on Meets or Exceeds Gains since turnaround.





All Composite Scores For Grades 3,4,5 Increase


Grade 3 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year



Grade 4 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year




Grade 5 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year




Grade 6 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year



Grade 7 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year




Grade 8 ISAT Composite Scores, by Year




Meets or Exceeds ISAT Composite Score, by Year, African American and White




Meets or Exceeds ISAT Composite Score, by Year, Hispanic and White



Exceeds ISAT Composite Score, by Year, African American and White




Exceeds ISAT Composite Score, by Year, Hispanic and White




Meets or Exceeds ISAT Composite Score, by Year, Gender
