Facilities Update



- Ivan Hansen appointed as Acting Chief Facilities Officer on 11/8. Since his appointment:
 - Held several meetings, during the week of 11/8, with the custodial and engineering teams to reiterate expectations and establish operational dashboards. Emphasized to the teams that principal communication is key.
 - Initiated conversations with Procurement and potential supplemental custodial vendors to identify additional staffing resources.
 - Continued after-hours cleaning for schools needing supplemental resources.
 - Streamlined a cleaning dashboard to identify and resolve critical cleaning issues. The team will continue to make enhancements to this tool.
 - Identified critical tasks to be completed for system implementation of Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS), which will be instrumental for improved custodial and engineering management and principal communication.
- Six custodial hiring job fairs will be held on 11/16, 11/17 and 11/18 for private and Board custodians with a focus on neighborhood hiring.
- Comprehensive Facilities Update will be provided at the December meeting of the Board of Education.

Transportation Update

Alternative transportation options for 3,260 students (1,877 diverse learners) who are without transportation services as a result of the nationwide bus driver shortage:

- **Financial Assistance for Families Self-Transporting their Children:** 710 families opted to self-transport their children for the entire 2021-22 school year. 458 families have children are diverse learners.
- **Ride-along Transportation:** To begin completing background checks on 38 drivers.
- **Non-attendance Students:** All 50 students have been routed and receiving service.
