

#### MORE RESOURCES AND STAFF IN OUR SCHOOLS

- Over **\$1 billion added to school budgets** since 2019
- Over **7,000 additional staff to schools** since 2019
  - 2,500 additional teachers
  - 4,000 additional SECAs
  - Hundreds of additional nurses, counselors, social workers, case managers, restorative justice coordinators, STLS coordinators

#### A MORE EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF RESOURCES

- Allocating resources based on student, school, and community need — not based solely on school enrollment
- Setting a new baseline for staffing and resources for every school, regardless of size or location.
- More reliance on our District's Opportunity Index to ensure a greater share of resources are reaching students and communities furthest from opportunity


