CPS Student Advisory Council Appointed Member

If you are selected as the Honorary Student Board Member, you are expected to serve as an appointed member to the CPS Student Advisory Council. The CPS Student Advisory Council is composed of 20 youth from high schools across the city. The group advises the Chief Executive Officer of Chicago Public Schools on the youth perspective of all school-related policies and issues. The Council members work in subcommittees with CPS leaders to develop action plans based on youth led research on building community investment in neighborhood schools. You would have the opportunity to participate in the 6-week research summer program (you will be paid for participating). As the 2019-2020 school year begins, sessions begin Mid-September with the expectation of 40 hours of attendance per semester (2-3 meetings per month). Meetings are often held on CPS off days and after school.

September 2019 – June 2020	Honorary Student Board Member attends CPS Student Advisory Council sessions with the expectation of 40 hours of attendance per semester (2-3 meetings per month) - often held on CPS off days and after school
