


SY23 Out of School Time (OST) Data


(OST Data includes programs funded by the OST Dept., Sustainable Community Schools (SCS) and Community Schools Initiative (CSI))



- **40% of students participated in OST/CSI/SCS programming** so far this year, up from 36% at this point last year
- **15,000 more students** participating in programming as compared to last year
- Increased attendance as compared to this time last year
- Increased program hours
- 170+ OST Community-Based Partners
- Improved program participation among all priority groups (Diverse Learners, Black and Latinx Males, and Chronically Truant).


