

Teacher Diversity Improves Student Outcomes




Our goal: Teachers as diverse as Chicago





Over 10+ years, teacher diversity has not improved






Diversity in higher education is a national challenge, but Illinois has it tougher than most

Nationally

➤ 35% decline since 2010 in number of students enrolled in teacher preparation programs

Illinois

- >54% decline in black enrollment
- ≥28% decline in Latinx enrollment



CPS 5-Year Vision: Success Starts Here





All solutions require dramatic increases in diverse hiring... ... and that can happen in two ways.

Get a bigger slice of pie

Hiring a larger percentage of diverse teacher candidates

Grow the pie

Increasing the number of diverse teacher candidates





What's beyond our 2024 goal in the CPS Vision?


PRIOR QUESTION
